

Traditional/Conventional Conference

- Familiar format
- Pre-arranged place and time
- Common theme
- Often Keynote and Closing Speakers
- Pre-determined sessions and speakers
- PowerPoint and Keynote presentation
- Sometimes includes discussion

Un-Conference

- Shift in format
- Pre-arranged place and time
- Participant-Driven
 - o Participants' Theme of Choice
 - Can have Keynote and/or Closing Speakers
 - o Participant created sessions
 - o Participants as facilitators
 - Discussion/Share-Based
 Participants flow freely between
 sessions, during sessions, according to
 interests –

HOW IT WORKS:

\star Discussion Based

- o Power is its participants
- o Not just expertise, but experience
- o Participants come Ready with Questions and Ready to Share

★ Content by Attendees

- o Topics come from interests/needs of participants
- o Sessions Built From Popular Topics
- o Unconference Organizers will group like topics
- o Topics with most interest will be arranged as a schedule on the Session Board

* Sessions Facilitated by Participants

- *o* Facilitators are NOT Presenters
 - Lead introductions (name, position, interest in this topic); all share
 - Open with question on topic for discussion
 - Keep discussion going (ask more questions as necessary)
 - Share Take-Home Resource, Links, or Materials

Participants "Vote With Their Feet"

- o The "Rule of Two Feet"
 - Participants are free to come and go from sessions as desired
 - If not connecting to current discussion session
 - If more interested in another, based on its message feeds
